The Founding Fathers were so Ingenious in creating our Nation, we often overlook simple solutions in our overly complicated lives.

By Studying and Understanding these Documents you will learn how to become your own Private Attorney General.

- The First Document is 6 steps to a Contract. When a Cop asks for your Signature on a Ticket he is Offering you a Contract, by signing it, you have accepted the Contract (Initiated Contract)

Learn how to Control Contracts and you can control Commerce, Study this more in depth on your own via Internet Research.

- Document 2 is the "A" Schedule. Contracts are agreements between 2 or more Parties, when the Cop hands you a Ticket, hand him an Invoice. Next time a Cop hands you a Ticket, advise him you will need his signature on your Invoice because once he has Initiated Contract, he is Liable for Deprivation of Rights under Color of Law, Code, or Statute. **ONLY CONGRESS CAN PASS LAWS.** States pass Code for Revenue

Generation which is Fraud. You are Entitled to Honest Goods and Services under Title 18 USC 1346

I use Cornell Law's "Get the Law" for reference. You will need to Study the Uniform Commercial Codes, U.S. Codes and the Bill of Rights.

Not all of them but certain sections. Title 18 are the Criminal Codes to use against Public Servants.

- Document 3 is the Flowchart, who knows how to File a Lawsuit? Not me, But by Utilizing this, you will become an opponent nobody wants to tangle with.
- Document 4 is Business and Professions Code form 6068 (The Attorney Oath) No Attorney follows the Law and with this Form you will bust them at their own game.
- Document-5 is Commercial Liens-1

Your personal Redress of Grievances against Public Officials who abuse their Office. Join our Study group at CAN Commercial Lien Strategies on Facebook.

- Document-6 The Constitutional Criminal Complaint.

This is a Step by Step Affidavit, Criminal Complaint, Commercial Lien all rolled into 1. Print an extra Copy to keep around as a Study Guide. You complete the steps, File with the Federal Clerk of Courts and await Payment on your Lien.

(Join our weekly call to learn this Process, this is NOT for just anyone. Diligence and hard work await you to achieve success)

- Document-7 Is the Disappearance Affidavit. If you intend to Prosecute Public Servants using the Constitutional Criminal Complaint, cover your ass. Complete this Affidavit, have it Notarized and File it with your County Sheriff Via Certified Mail. (Lawful Service)
- Document -8 The Oath of Office Laws.... People cannot comprehend that the Bill of Rights is the Terms and Conditions for Employment in Public Service. YOU in your Individual Capacity are the Employer. When a Public Servant Employee harms you, you can charge them for Breach of Oath against their Oath of Office and Surety Bond.
- Document-9 The Uniform Bonding Code. You can Download the entire Document on Google. (Google the Uniform Bonding Code PDF) Read it and memorize it!!! Especially Study Sections 5.2, 5.3, 5.4, 5.5 and 9.2

If you are fighting a Court Case. Have Documents 3, 4, and 9 entered onto the Record and added to your Court File. Get all Public Servant Oaths from the County Clerk and ask them for the Bonds to go with each Oath. Video all your interactions with Public Servants and take Witness's with you. After you are done, ask each Witness to Write the Events of the day in their own words and sign it. When signed by 2 others, this becomes an **Affidavit of Fact** . (Study the Affidavit)
